In the context of his international collaborations, the **Laboratory of Research on Practical Philosophy** (L.R.P.Ph.) welcomes Professor David J. Elliott of the Steinhardt School of Education at the Department of Culture and Human Development, Department of Music & Performing Arts Professions of the University of New York, and Associate Professor Marissa Silverman, Coordinator of the Undergraduate Department of Music Education of the John J. Cali School of Music, University of Montclair State, New York.

Professor and philosopher of Music Education David Elliott, as a founder of Praxial Philosophy for Music Education, has been honored with international awards for his music and his humanitarian contribution, either as an academic or as a musician. References to his core reference book on Music Education: "Music Matters: a New Philosophy of Music Education" count in thousands.

In 2018 he began his collaboration with the *Laboratory of Research on Practical Philosophy* (L.R.P.Ph.), of the Department of Preschool Education Sciences and Educational Design (D.P.E.S.E.D.) of the University of the Aegean, in the framework of his central talk at the 1st International Biennale of Practical Philosophy under the title "Philosophy in Action. The Philosophical Gesture: Political, Ethical, Educational, Artistic Activities" held in Rhodes on 27, 28, 29 April 2018, as well as in the framework of the Post-congress international seminar of professional development (CPD), entitled "Playing" with Gestures": Aspects and Concerns of the Praxial Philosophy of Music Education in the Classroom". On the basis of this evolving important collaboration, the *Laboratory of Research on Practical Philosophy* & professor Elena Theodoropoulou brought before the D.P.E.S.E.D.'s Assembly the professor's David Elliott nomination as his Honorary Doctorate.
